

Miller Golf Course Annual Meeting

The 2019 golf course season is fast approaching, so we will bring you up-to-date on some of our course plans and activities. The clubhouse will open on April 1st this year.

We are looking forward to an enjoyable year as our irrigation system is working well and is keeping the course very green. We have had good support for the irrigation project, but we continue to encourage contributions to this great project regardless of the size of the donation. We have paid our loan balance down to approximately \$79,751.43 plus accumulated interest to date. We also took out a loan for \$10,000 to pay for a portion of the new deck. We have made some improvements to the course including new doors, new cooler, and a new deck.

Pam Heasley & Ron Rembold will be co-managing the clubhouse this year. John Goehring will once again be our course Superintendent

We also have golf round punch cards from \$100 for 10 rounds as well as gift certificates to the clubhouse that can be purchased for \$25, \$50, and \$100.

We will be putting the tournament schedule out a little bit later this spring once we can get some dates finalized for tournaments as well as tournament committee members selected for the year. If you are on a tournament committee and cannot assist with the tournament please find your own substitute to assist with the tournament.

We have enclosed the 2019 membership form which shows the fee structure. Members **MUST** fill out a membership form and turn it in with payment to either Kristal Volquardsen, or Pam & Ron. This is needed for record/book keeping of the course. This year the board has made some changes. As most of you know, we are a non-profit organization, and we intend to operate as lean as possible while providing a great golf experience for our members and guests. We have increased our membership rates this year to be more in line with the rates of neighboring courses in our area. We have increased the rental fees for the clubhouse as well. \$250 for Graduations and \$500 for other events to fall more in line with other facilities. Plans are to continue the gun raffle this year with the funds being set up into a separate account for course improvement. A big thank you to Dylan Templeton for heading up this project. The 2019 budget and financials will be distributed and discussed at the annual meeting.

In closing, a special thanks to all the paid staff and volunteers who made last year a success. Special thanks to Nehemia Volquardsen and Brian Bonebright for their years of service to this board. Other nominations will be considered at the annual meeting.
